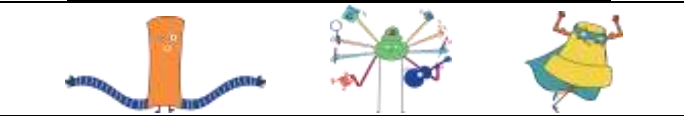

This term we have been developing our shared school approach toward things which help children in school and in class. We have had some training in the last year from Miss. Jackson and United Learning in a really positive approach called 'Conscious Discipline', which teachers and teaching assistants have found gives a lot of useful ideas to help children focus on their learning in a constructive way.

STAR breathing is a Conscious Discipline technique for when we feel that we need a calming breath:



We have a nice routine also for bringing focus to learning too:

STAR- Active Engagement

S – Sit up straight, stay engaged
T – Track the teacher-looking and listening
A – Ask and answer questions
R – Respect others
