

Smart Phone Safety Tips from our parents:

Recommendation for an app called Family Link. "When our son got an android phone for his 11th birthday we set it up with a child's Google account and linked it to our phones with the family link app. With this app we are able to see how much time he spends on certain apps, we can set downtime and choose how long he can use it each day. We can lock it from our phones, check his location and approve games and apps. He cannot download anything or go on any website without our password or approval."
