



We were very lucky last year to have Mrs. Beatty with us, who ran Forest School 'Glee Bees' for small groups and after school two days a week. We sadly don't have the funding to replace Mrs. Beatty now and so we are building outdoor opportunities into learning and playtimes as much as we can. YR and Nursery continue to have forest school type activities weekly called 'welly walks' as part of their early years' provision. We are seeking a forest school type after school provider and we'll let you know if this is possible. This will have a small charge to cover costs, if we can find a provider. We know Forest School is popular and we'll do what we can.

Applying for school places reminder
It is time to apply for places at secondary school for parents of children in Y6. It is also time to apply for YR places for Sept 2025. Please ask the office team if you are unsure how to do this.

House on the school site update
Last year we received the go ahead and change of use planning permission to make the house on site part of the school grounds. We have now included the house in the school grounds with a new fence and you can now see the space has lots of potential! We had a big clear up of the garden last term and found lots of paving slabs. Would anyone like these as we need to remove them? Our next step is to help the PTA with a shed as they use the house for storage. We then hope to clear

and refresh the indoors.

If you need to ask anything, tell us anything or have any worries about your child at school then please contact the office team or pop in. They will try to help you and/or pass on your message to the right person. Please allow us time to respond to your enquiries. Schools are busy places and we cannot always reply to you immediately if you need to speak to someone in particular. Emergencies are different of course but please give teachers and other staff at least two days to respond to your requests for a call or a meeting. Meetings are possible, we just need to arrange cover for people and a suitable time for all. We ask particularly that all parents and carers continue to speak to school staff respectfully, whatever the reason for a conversation. This is an expectation at this school at all times, as I am sure you appreciate. We will always investigate any concerns as soon as we are able and we aim to listen and to respect parents and carers in return. We also like to share good news about your children with you!

School Senior Leadership Team: Our school has a Lower School Leader and that is Miss. Williams, our Assistant Head. She leads the EYFS and

KS1 team. We also have an Upper School Leader and that is Mrs. Peace, our Deputy Head. She leads the KS2 team. Our Special Needs Co-ordinator is Miss. Jackson. Mrs. Groves leads our pastoral team (Haven) and she is our Designated Safeguarding Leader. Miss. Jackson and I are Deputy Safeguarding Leaders. Mrs Domagala is our Business Manager.
