

### Online happiness for children at home.

Children can sometimes become unhappy when communicating online through games and group chats at home. It can be upsetting and they can be exposed to bad language and other unsafe behaviour from others they are talking to online. Please monitor and keep an eye on all online interactions that your children have at home and stop the interaction if you need to. Primary school aged children are not old enough for some of the emotional issues which social media and gaming can potentially bring and this is why most games and social media contact is only recommended for age thirteen plus. If you do allow online interactions at home, please check in and keep checking in with your children so that you know exactly what they are doing, what is being said and that is it safe, appropriate and not upsetting in any way.
