Curriculum Information for the Summer Term: Nursery, YR and KS1.

Nursery

PREHISTORIC ADVENTURE!: What was on the Earth a long time ago?



What we are up to: This half term the children in our Pear Tree Nursery will be learning all about what was on the Earth a long time ago. They will learn about dinosaurs and read some great texts by Jane Yolen, including 'How do dinosaurs say I love you?' and 'How do dinosaurs learn colours and numbers?'. The children will be inspired by the dinosaurs to complete their own learning such as learning the numbers 1-5. They will also discuss the stories they have listened to, talk about the events and characters in a book and suggest how a story might end. The children will develop their sharing and playing skills and also build their independence. On their Welly Walks the Nursery children will complete scavenger hunts, identify signs of Spring and Summer and make flower crowns. Our children who will be starting school in September, will also begin their first phonics lessons in the summer term! What else are we up to: Nursery also have an exciting trip to the library coming up soon!

Reception

PREHISTORIC ADVENTURE!: What was on the Earth a long time ago?



What we are up to: In our Reception classes, the children have got an exciting half term learning about dinosaurs coming up! The children will be learning about ancient prehistoric creatures, archaeological digs and what the Earth was like when dinosaurs were alive! The children will explore some of our key texts, including 'Dinosaur Lady' by Linda Skeers and 'Cave Baby' by Julia Donaldson. The children will learn all about Mary Anning and how she was the first palaeontologist. This half term, the children in Reception will also be enjoying their Welly Walks and Forest School sessions. They will be identifying the signs of Spring and Summer and planting a seed to watch it grow.

What else are we up to: Reception also have an exciting trip to the library coming up soon!

Year 1

NATURE DETECTIVES! : What can we find at the bottom of the garden?



What we are up to: In Year 1, the children will be learning all about nature this half term and will enjoy getting outside in their Forest School sessions. The children will learn about plants in their science lessons and will be growing sunflower flower seeds. They will also be creating outside art sculptures inspired by the artist Andy Goldsworthy. Year 1 will continue to develop their reading, writing and maths and be inspired by key texts such as 'Journey' by Arron Becker and 'On the Way Home' by Jill Murphy. This half term the children in Year 1 will be doing lots of phonics practice in the run up to their Phonics Screening Check in June.

Year 2

WE ARE GEOGRAPHERS- BRAZIL! Who are the Indigenous Tribes of the Amazon Rainforest?



will be learning all about the Amazon rainforest and the people who live there. They will be learning about how indigenous tribes survive in such difficult climates and compare Brazil with the UK. They will be investigating what plants need to grow in their science lessons and will create an experiment to test the impact of removing either light, soil, air or water from a growing plant. In DT, the children will be practising their cutting skills to make fruit faces. Year 2 will continue to develop their reading, writing and maths and be inspired by key texts such as 'The Tunnel' by Anthony Brown and 'Augustus and his Smile' by Catherine Rayner.

What else are we up to: Y2 can also look forward to our upcoming trip to Arundel Castle in June and our Forest School sessions later in the summer term!


