#### Y5/6 toilet facilities update

We wanted to give an update on the Y5/6 toilet facilities. We have been working with United Learning for some time as the toilets are very old and in need of complete refurbishment. The work that is required will cost upwards of £200,000.00 which is more than the school is able to afford. We are very pleased to say that our funding bid was approved in late July 2025 as a priority by United Learning and we will soon have the year 5/6 toilet blocks fully refurbished. As the refurbishment will require several weeks of disruptive building work, the earliest that this can now be carried out will be during the summer holidays of 2026.

In the meantime, we are keeping the old toilets in the best condition that we possibly can. The toilets are cleaned at least three times during the school day. The cisterns have been updated in the last two years to update them from the old pull chains to more modern push buttons.

We have frequent work done on the urinals in the boys' block. The sinks, taps and mirrors have also been replaced in the last two years, we took out some old wooden sink units and replaced them with more hygienic stainless steel sinks. The toilet walls were painted last year. The walls and flooring are thoroughly cleaned but they do look old and worn out.

The school will be monitoring the toilets regularly in order to maintain them as much as possible whilst we wait for the major refurbishment work to happen next year. The Y5/6 toilets are safe and our cleaning team make sure there is soap and everything needed.

We have done all we can to maintain the Y5/6 toilet blocks over time and we are sorry they are not as nice yet as the newer ones built in 2017 across the rest of the school. Mr. Williams, Premises Manager.

# Pear Tree Nursery tours


