If you are in receipt of benefits, and apply for free school meals, our school could receive a learning grant of up to £1300 per child!

Free school meals are not the same as the Universal Meal Entitlement for Reception, Year 1 and 2. Every child is entitled to a free meal in Early Years and Key Stage 1 but free school meals can last throughout your child's time with us and bring in valuable extra funds to the school.
